Judging Category Children ages 7-14

Art Materials No size requirement, white poster paper
Markers, crayon, ink or watercolor
DO NOT use pencil, charcoal or chalk

Theme **Children Act Fast, So Do Poisons and Poisonings Span a Lifetime**

Judging Criteria **25% Originality** (Keep concepts simple)
25% Design (Make it clear and clean – remember it will be on a billboard)
25% Neatness (Be sure spelling is correct)
25% Poison Prevention Message
