

COVID-19 VACCINATION TIMELINE

PHASE 1A: DECEMBER TO JANUARY

Healthcare personnel

- Employees at hospitals, home health care, pharmacies, EMS, dentists, outpatient care, optometrists, behavioral health, veterinarians

Long-term care facility residents and staff



PHASE 1B: FEBRUARY TO MID-MARCH

TIER 1

- People 75 and older

TIER 2

- First responders: Fire, police, dispatch, FBI, adult/child welfare
- Utilities: Power, water, gas and sanitation
- Homeless shelter staff
- Corrections staff
- Educators: Teachers, higher education, support staff
- Child care providers

TIER 3

- Funeral homes, coroners
- Grocery employees
- Food/Agriculture: Meat packing plants, food processing, co-ops

TIER 4

- Transportation: Trucking, railroad, gas stations
- U.S. Postal Service
- Public transit: Bus, air



PHASE 1C: MARCH TO APRIL

- People 65-74 years old
- People with high-risk medical conditions
- Congregate settings: Incarcerated individuals, colleges/universities

PHASE 2: MAY TO OCTOBER

General Population
